For auld &c.*

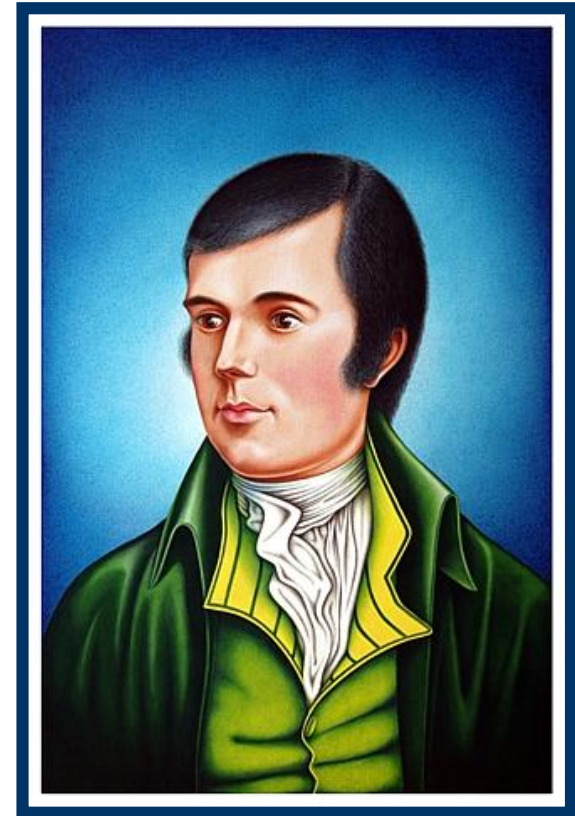
*We twa hae run about the braes,
